Buses: Will need to drop students off at the front of the building, which is the north side of the building next to the football field and press box. After dropping students off, busses will need to park at the CDC building across the street from Perry at the corner of Perry and Pearl St. Busses may also drop off on the East side of the building.

Parent Parking: Parents may park at any location around the school. Extra parking will be at the Administration building, CDC building, and at Carrollton Elementary. All 3 buildings are located on Perry St. Walking time from all three building is approximately 5 minutes. All doors to the school will be unlocked and available for parents and students to enter.

Students May warm up in the big gym or small gym. NO PLAYING in the cafeteria. Percussion students will be allowed to warm up in the Band hall on drum pads. No snare drums will be allowed in the Band hall. NO students should play in the COURTYARDS. When a student has finished auditioning they should pack their instrument, stand, and music and go to the cafeteria to await their departure.

Band Director meeting will begin at 8:00 AM in the library. A light breakfast and coffee will be served at 7:30 AM. Lunch will be provided starting at 11:30 when your room is scheduled for a break. When the audition process concludes, please take down and fold the black sheet, clip the clothes pins to the black sheet and place stands in the hallway. This will be the sign for the RLT students to clean your room.

Monitor Meeting: will begin at 8:00 AM in the Auditorium. No food is provided for the monitors. However the concession stand is open from 8:30-4:30. RL Turner students will be available to answer any questions.

For Your Students

Students need to label everything they bring with their name and their school. They are going to be responsible for their stands, folders, instruments, and music.

Please instruct your students to remain in the cafeteria or gym unless they are auditioning, warming up to audition, or waiting outside their room to audition.

Students should not wait until the end of their window to report to their room.

The warm up area is not a practice area.

NO STUDENTS SHOULD PLAY IN THE COURTYARDS.

We will have many students involved in other activities on the day of auditions, and students coming to audition late need to be fit in before the last window is scheduled to close.
