5:30 PM: Arrive at your clinic site

- Case should be left in the designated area
- Find your chair in the band set-up in the rehearsal area.
- Your name will be attached to a music stand indicating your seat
- Bring extra reeds, oil, grease, REHEARSAL PENCIL, etc.
- Please do not play until the clinician asks you to.
- Please leave chairs and stands in their original placement in the rehearsal area
- Please make sure you have practiced and prepared your music in this folder before coming to the clinic. Your prior preparation will improve the entire band's performance allowing the clinician to work on higher level concepts with the band.

6:00 PM: Rehearsal Begins

- Please be prepared to begin on time. We want to maximize our limited rehearsal time.

8:30 PM: Rehearsal Ends

- Take your instrument and music home with you.

Saturday Schedule:

8:15 AM: Arrive at your clinic site (same location as Friday evening)

8:30 AM: Rehearsal begins

11:30 AM: BREAK FOR LUNCH.

- Your band directors or parents are responsible for transportation and all lunch plans.

1:30 PM - 3:00 PM: Afternoon rehearsal for Symphonic Band, Honors Band, Wind Ensemble and Wind Symphony (unless breaking for Wayne Bergeron presentation from 1:45-2:15 PM).

1:30 PM - 1:45 PM: Concert Band change clothes into Concert attire

1:45 PM - 2:15 PM: Listen to/watch Wayne Bergeron!

2:15 PM - 4:15 PM: Concert Band afternoon rehearsal

Concert in the Reedy HS Auditorium

- Concert Band - perform at 4:30 PM
- Symphonic Band - 4:30 PM warm-up in Reedy HS band hall; perform at 5:15 PM
- Honors Band - 5:15 PM warm-up in Reedy HS band hall; perform at 6:00 PM
- Wind Ensemble- 6:00 PM warm-up in Reedy HS band hall; perform at 6:45 PM
- Wind Symphony - 6:45 PM warm-up in Reedy HS band hall; perform at 7:30 PM

Concert Procedure

Be on time to warm-up, and please remember other students may be performing as you enter the building. Medals will be presented to you at the conclusion of your performance. Following your performance your band will file off the stage and pack instruments. You are free to depart campus or go into the auditorium and enjoy the remaining performances. Please remember to be respectful of the other performers and audience members at all time!

General Information

- **Lunch** - There are many restaurants located near the campuses.
- **Concert Dress** will be dark concert attire - black is preferable. Dress up! This is not a casual occasion. Please wear clothing that is suitable for playing your instrument. Band uniforms or concert uniforms are recommended. Please use your best judgment to look to look professional! Your director will advise you.
- **Changing Clothes** - Plan to change during the break between rehearsal and warm-up. **Concert Band students:** You will need to bring your concert attire with you and change prior to your afternoon rehearsal at Reedy HS.
- **Professional Digital Recordings** will be available for purchase at the concert.
- **Music** - At the conclusion of the concert please keep your music and folder as a souvenir of your Region Band experience.
- **Absence at the concert or from any part of the rehearsals forfeits your right to an All-Region Medal and the distinction of being an All-Region Band Member.**
