NOW! Where most of the experienced players likely have been practicing regularly, some of you might need to get your instruments out and blow the dust off of them! We will have new chair tests shortly after the beginning of school, so make sure you practice! You should be practicing long tones, lip slurs, scales, and the music that you received at the end of school.

Summer lessons will continue through Tuesday, August 18th. Please continue to allow your child to take lessons when school starts, as they are essential to their musical development. Over 95% of All-State Band students take private lessons. All students using a school-owned instrument: Oboe, Bassoon, Bass Clarinet, Tenor Sax,
Baritone Sax, French Horn, Euphonium, or Tuba need to make a payment
to MyPaymentsPlus. Your account should already have an instrument rental fee listed. This
fee is for routine chemical cleaning and maintenance done during the summer following
use. Please make this payment by the first day of Summer Band.

We will play on the first day of school. Please have your child bring their instrument, equipment and supplies for rehearsal.

Please check the Band Handbook (Clarkband.org) for details about our uniform policy. We will be using the same uniforms as last year. The cost of the polo shirt is \$25.00, and it will be used for the next two years. If you no longer have a Band t-shirt, if it is damaged,

or if it no longer fits, the replacement cost is \$15.00. Please note that allConcert, Honor, and Symphonic Band students must also purchase black dress shoes, black socks, black dress pants, and a black belt. Ladies may wear low heeled, closed-toed shoes, and a long, at least anklelength, black dress, if they prefer. No strapless or low-cut dresses will be allowed. A step-up instrument should last a student through 8th grade, high school, and perhaps college. It is of better quality and more expensive, but retains much of its value over time! These horns have significantly less repair costs due to their quality.

Clarinet: Buffet R13

Alto Saxophone: Selmer S80 Series II or Series III

Trumpet: Yamaha 8335 "Xeno" or Bach S180-37 "Stradivarius"

Trombone: Bach 42 BO or Conn 88HO

Contact a band director about finding the best deal for you on a new or used instrument! If your family would have to make a choice between getting a new instrument OR taking private lessons, choose private lessons!
